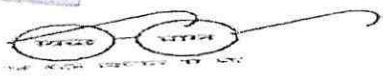

Recommendation of the committee constituted on behalf of Hon'ble
Chief Minister to review the Schemes /Programmes being implemented
by the Rural Development Department.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to inform you that a Committee to review critical flagship programmes such as Swachh Bharat Mission- Gramin, Kaushal Vikas Yojana & Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana etc. being implemented by the state Government has been constituted by the state to review the above said Schemes /Programmes. On the basis of recommendation of the committee it is requested to:-

- To conduct an IEC campaign in your district on the benefits of the Twin Pit Technology and its benefit and long run impact on environment.
- The Gram Panchayats be sensitized to think in terms of safe disposal, trained to estimate and treat/dispose of their waste and feel proud of their achievement.
- A movement /campaign be started by each Gram Panchayat to register the kabadiwallas in their jurisdiction who in turn will be responsible for collecting and transporting the waste from the concerned Gram Panchayat. For this purpose the Gram Panchayats can think of constructing Waste Collection /Segregation Sheds if required, from where the kabadiwallas can collect the waste.
- The Gram Panchayats should levy monthly charges on the Households/Shops etc. of the Gram Panchayat for waste management of the concerned GP. In this regard, it is very important that waste be segregated in the household itself by the householders and then collected and transported to a waste collection/segregation shed where further segregation be done if required.
- For Bio-degradable waste, each household be made aware of Composting technology /methods and additional support through MGNREGS like including in shelf of works the vermin-composting pits for households so that each households Bio-degradable waste is disposed off in environmentally sound way and with the additional benefits to household.
- All the Gram Panchayats in the periphery of Urban Local Bodies like Municipal Committees/Municipal Councils and Cities etc. should collaborate with them so that



waste collected by the Gram Panchayats could be disposed off in the waste disposal facilities/plants managed by these Urban Local Bodies.

- In the HP Panchayati Raj Act, there is ample provision for GPs to penalize the households /institutions and others who are violating the instructions/orders of the GPs regarding maintenance of the sanitation status of the GPs. In this respect, the Gram Panchayats should act strictly accordingly to the HP Panchayati Raj Act and Challan/impose penalties on the polluters specifically in the adjoining areas of the Gram Panchayats to the Parwanoo and BBN belt (Baddi, Barotiwala, Nalagarh) etc.
- Regular cleanliness drives be conducted in each GP through Yuvak Mandals /Mahila Mandals/SHGs etc. for cleaning the Gram Panchayat area and IEC of the rural population regarding safe sanitation and hygienic practices.
