Last dates for Submission of Online application for Fresh (first time applicant) and Renewal (applicant who have got scholarship during 2017-18) scholarship by students.

Eligibility

- The applicant should belong to any one from the notified minority communities viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains
- Pursuing studies in India in Government or Private Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools.
- The course being pursued in of minimum one year duration.
- The applicant should have secured 50% marks in the last annual Board/Class examination.

- Application are advised to apply online against any one of the scholarship scheme on the Website of National Scholarship Portal at-www.gov.in(a link to the site is also available at-www.minorityaffairs.gov.in)
- Detailed 'Instructions' for filling in online application and 'frequently Asked Question (FAQs)' are available on the National Scholarship Portal homepage.
- Applicant is advised to give only that bank account details which remains in active mode or compliant as per bank's instruction so that payment of scholarship does not fail.

For Universities/Institutes/College/Schools

- All Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools, where a minority students is studying. Should get themselves registered (if not done earlier) on National Scholarship Portal by 15th August, 2018.
